Join us for a guided tour of the James R. Browning US Court of Appeals Building. Completed in 1905, this imposing structure is listed in the National Register of Historic Places. Although its detailed and ornamented exterior is impressive, the elegant interiors are even more exquisite, and include marble from Italy and North Africa, stained-glass domes, and majestic spaces punctuated with marble-mosaic tile and gilded plaster eagles.
